Staff "Uni-Forum" Roundtable was held on Wednesday, April 11th and brainstormed the following:

- Immediate Solutions
- Improvements for 2018-19

Results:

- Student and Teacher Uniform Reset
- Acquiring inventory to create a "uniform rental station"
- Daily uniform detentions (teachers have expressed an interest in volunteering)
- Establishing a student roundtable to hear their thoughts
- Creation of a "Lottery"- a raffle that allows students in uniform each day the chance to be rewarded for adhering to expectations.
- Locker Reset for 2018-19 (providing students with more accessible locker locations)

Teacher Evaluations:

- Teachers received feedback on instructional delivery, adherence to school initiatives and a review of course documents

Facilities and Safety

Facilities:

- The building continues to have issues with the exterior windows leaking during heavy rainfall
- All heating units are operational and are prepared for seasonal shut-down
- Department of Buildings Elevator Inspector visited the facility on 4-13-18 and issued tww (2) violations for the maintenance of the elevator pitts and for no Data tag located in the elevator machine room

Safety:

- A temporary addition to the Safety team was made to assist the Safety Department in lieu of active shooter incidents.
- There were reports of four (3) student altercations on property and (4) off property NYPD reports were made by the complainants
- No Fire Department, Environmental Control Board or Health Department visits were made to the school for the month

Student Walkouts:

In response to the walkout on 3/14 and in preparation for the walkout on 4/20, the Accountability and Development Department worked with School Counsel and Administration to develop a protocol for school walkouts moving forward. A&D also assisted with a letter to the NYC DOE, drafted a letter to WCHS parents and guardians, and created a press release describing the school walkout and events on 4/20.

2017-2018 LEA Desk Review Due May 8, 2018:

NYSED is conducting a Desk Review of WCHS to determine compliance with requirements outlined in the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and New York State Commissioner's Regulations. They are collecting programmatic and fiscal requirements for Title I and Title 2.

Operations
