

WCHS Financial Update May 15, 2018

As of March 31, 2018 total collected revenue for 9 months is \$11,780,250 million and total expenses for 9 months are \$11,576,810 million.

Excess of revenue over expenses for the period 7/1/17-3/31/18 is \$203,440.

Facilities and Safety

Facilities:

- The schools Heating and Air Conditioning system units have been shut down throughout the school due to cool weather and only being used if a weather change ensues. Thermostats have been locked as a part of the energy savings program
- There has been no new issues with vandalism
- A summer cleaning program is prepared for the school
- An FDNY Inspector visited the property to inspect the schools HVAC units on 5/5/18 with no violations issued
- An FDNY Inspector visited the school on 5/8/18 to inspect the schools Certificate of occupancy. A 30 day extension was allowed for the owner to renew. No violation issued

Safety:

- There continues to be off property incidents involving student altercations off school grounds
- There have been two reported in-school student altercations
- Two new proposals were submitted for contracted Security
- The schools Special Armed guard coverage has been suspended as of 5/9/18
- No major incidents to report

Accountability and Development

WCHS has formally been accepted by the NYSED Board of Regents and will be authorized under them starting July 1. Two outside community entities have been using or will be utilizing WCHS space over the next few weeks. We donated space to a music school displaced by the closing of the DIY venue, Silent Barn. They will be using classrooms from May 7-June 18. A former student, Ray Persaud, will also be using WCHS space to film a short anti-gun violence piece in June. Mr. Persaud is from the first graduating class at WCHS. A local middle school may also use the Cafetorium for their prom. We are also beginning to plan for charter renewal, which will start in Fall 2018.
