

Great news! New York State introduces "P-EBT" (P for pandemic) - a new benefit that gives every NYC public school family \$420 per child.

No sign-up is required. All families of NYC public school children, regardless of your immigration status, income, or employment, will receive this money.

If you already have an EBT card or a Medicaid card, the money will automatically be added to your card.

If you do not have an EBT card, you will receive one in the mail. If you are concerned that the State of New York may not have your correct address, please call 1-888-328-6399.

Families of non-public school students should contact the State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance to learn if they are eligible.

#### PANDEMIC EBT (P-EBT)

- WAVE 1-HOUSEHOLDS WITH SNAP OR PA BENEFITS ADDED TO YOUR CARD, \$193 BY EARLY JUNE AND \$227BY THE END OF JUNE.
- WAVE 2- IF YOU HAVE MEDICAID, BUT NOT SNAP OR PA BENEFITS MAYBE ADDED TO A MEDICAID COMMON BENEFIT IDENTIFICATION CARD (CBIC) AND A PIN NUMBER WILL BE ASSIGNED. ONE TIME PAYMENT OF \$420.
- WAVE 3- HOUSEHOLDS NOT ENROLLED IN SNAP, PA, OR MEDICAID. A CARD WILL BE ISSUED AND MAILED TO THE HOUSEHOLD FOR EACH STUDENT, ONE PAYMENT OF \$420 BEGINNING IN JULY AND AUGUST.


