

HOW TO SUPPORT YOUR SCHOLAR IN TRIMESTER 3, A FRESH START WITH MS. MCFADDEN



INCOMPLETES FOR TRIMESTER 2

- Check PowerSchool for your scholar's final grades for Trimester 2.
- If your scholar failed a class(es) they may still have a chance to pass that class with an incomplete.
- Incompletes are class assignments given to a scholar to help them pass failing class(es) in the prior Trimester.
- The highest grade they can receive in a class with the incomplete is a 70.
- If your scholar is in grades 9-11 and failed a class(es) you must request an incomplete contract from the teacher.
- Seniors do not have to request incompletes. Teachers will send the incomplete contact to them.
- Teachers will make a decision if your 9-11 grade scholar will receive the incomplete contact and assignments.



INCOMPLETE FOR TRIMESTER 2

- If your scholar did not attend class or make any attempt to pass the class.
 He/she may not be approved for an incomplete.
- Make sure your scholar completes the incomplete assignments and return it back to the teacher by the due date to received credit.
- 2 weeks after the submission of the assignment, check PowerSchool to see
 if your scholar is now passing the failed class from Trimester 2.
- If your scholar still has a failing grade in that class. Contact the teacher to find out the reason for the failure. Your scholar may not have completed the assignment or turned it in on time.



TRIMESTER 3

- Spring Break is April 2 9. This is a great time for your scholar to work on their incomplete assignments from Trimester 2.
- March 25 and March 26 are Virtual Parent-Advisor Conferences. You will meet with your scholar's Grade advisor. The school will contact you for an appointment. Please attend to discuss grades, attendance, etc. This is not a Parent Teacher meeting.
- Make sure your scholar is staying on track by doing and submitting their class assignments daily.
- If your scholar has missing assignments. The weekend is a good time to catch up on missing assignments.
- Check PowerSchool for missing assignments.
- Look in google classroom for missing assignments. Your scholar can show you
 what assignments are missing in google classroom.



TRIMESTER 3

- Make sure your scholar is getting a good night's sleep.
- Make sure your scholar is attending class daily, on time and answering the advisory question for attendance.
- If you have a current Junior. Now is the time for you and your scholar to identify
 Teachers that can write your scholar a College Recommendation letter.
- Start looking for summer jobs, internships and programs for your scholar.
- Encourage your child to do their best. If you need support, reach out to your scholar's Academy Leader or Counselor. They are there to help with educational and emotional support for your scholar.


