



# Formatting Tips



- Font should be a common, easily readable font
  - Generally safe fonts: Times New Roman, Calibri, Arial, Garamond
  - Keep font consistent, do not switch between fonts

#### Font sizes:

- 16 28 point font for resume header
- 12 14 for section headers
- 11 12 for experience entries
- Page margins should be between 0.5" to 1"
- Entries should be in reverse chronological order
- Sections & Headings should include:
  - Education
  - Leadership & Experience
    - Include internships, any jobs (part-time, temp/seasonal, babysitting, etc.), regular volunteering, leadership positions in school or other extracurricular activities
  - Additional Activities (optional, if student has several extracurriculars)
    - Include other involvement here, such as sports, one-time volunteer activities
  - Skills
    - Include computer, language, and any certifications



# Content Tips



#### Include city, state, phone number, and email

- New York, NY | (212) 555-5555 | name@gmail.com
- Not necessary to include exact address
- Email should be kept professional i.e., school email or name@server.com

### · Quantify work and accomplishments when possible

- "Supervised groups of 10 children, ages 7-12, on school trips, 8 hours a week."
- Use Active Power Verbs to start each bullet point
  - "Completed", "Arranged", "Led", "Assisted", "Collaborated", "Supported"
  - Use a variety of verbs, do not keep reusing the same ones
  - Use present tense for current experiences, past tense for completed experiences
- Bullet points should highlight specific skills, projects & accomplishments
  - 1-3 bullet points for each entry
  - Do not use first-person pronouns
- Include any awards, honors, scholarships, recognitions
  - GPA, if 3.2 (~87%) or above
  - AP, College Now, and other advanced courses
  - Honor Roll, employee of the month, competition awards, etc.
















Are we as parents proactive in our scholars Education? Or are we waiting until the school notifies us our scholar is failing?




Encourage our scholars to pass all classes with the highest grades they can get (give positive encouragement)
