





COVID-positivity rate as of 2/7/22



COVID Cases by Vaccination Status



COVID-19 Positivity as of 2/7/22



COVID Safety & Emergency Preparedness Updates

TESTING

- Weekly PCR Testing: BioReference Labs is continuing NYC DOE Student COVID-19 Screening Testing Program that began on 10/15/21. Weekly testing of up to 20% of unvaccinated OR vaccinated students with consent forms currently testing between 50-90 students per week.
- At Home Kits: WCHS received 1048 initial kits.
 Students and staff are provided with at-home tests if show symptoms or deemed as close contact.
 Additional kits received to distribute prior to midwinter break.

QUARANTINE/ISOLATION UPDATES:

- NYS has issued new guidance re: length of quarantine for staff who test positive for COVID-19
- Reduced quarantine from 10 to 5 days for asymptomatic staff or staff with improved symptoms





The facility underwent a water leak issue due to a ConEdison underground problem. This resulting in a gas line issue whereas leaks in the gas lines were found. The lines were repaired as of 2/8/22

- 1- Renovations for the Staff Lounge is ongoing
- 2-The schools fire pump is scheduled for repair to replace the packing seals that became worn, Vendor rescheduled the original work date
- 3-Building inspections were conducted during inclimate weather below 20 degrees on the weekends for potential freezing pipes
- 4-The schools DOB hearing for a boiler room infraction was completed with a reduced fine
- 5-FDNY responded to the school two times due to a National Grid issue






